

Sunday Supplement – HIStory Week 4

“From Passover to the Wedding Feast”

Exodus 12 • Matthew 26 • Revelation 19:7–9 (ESV)

Summary Points

- God redeems His people — first through the Passover in Egypt (Exodus 12), and ultimately through Jesus, our perfect Lamb.
- God reminds His people — the Lord’s Supper (Matthew 26) is a covenant meal that points us back to Christ’s sacrifice and love.
- God rejoices with His people — the Marriage Supper of the Lamb (Revelation 19) is a future celebration of eternal union with Christ.
- Jesus’ death is the ultimate 'bride price' — paid to make us His Bride. We now live as people invited to that joyful feast.
- Holiness is preparation for the wedding — sanctification readies us to meet our Bridegroom in love and purity.

Reflection Questions

- When did you first receive God's redemption? How do you continue to live in that freedom?
- How does the Lord’s Supper help you remember and respond to God’s love personally?
- What areas of your life might God be preparing or refining to make you ready for the Marriage Supper of the Lamb?

Action Steps This Week

- Read Exodus 12, Matthew 26, and Revelation 19. Reflect on the thread of covenant and celebration.
- Reflect on communion and why it’s important to remember the Passover, Jesus’ death, and the future marriage supper of the Lamb.
- Live each day as part of the Bride — ask God to grow holiness, love, and readiness in your heart.
