

Sunday Supplement: Invitations of Grace – Week 1

Summary Points

- Paul is astonished that the Galatians are deserting grace for a distorted gospel.
- The gospel of grace cannot be edited, expanded, or earned—it is Christ alone.
- To shift from trust to striving is to trade freedom for fear.
- The church must hold fast to grace and refuse to perform for approval.

Reflection Questions

- Where do I find myself tempted to earn what God has already freely given?
- Have I added anything to grace in how I view myself—or others?
- Whose approval am I most concerned with: God's or people's?
- What does it look like for me to live from acceptance rather than for it?

Suggested Action Steps

- Memorize Galatians 1:10 to anchor your identity in Christ's approval.
- Write down the ways you've seen God's grace shape your life and share one with someone this week.
- Invite someone to church who may have been burned by legalism or performance-based religion.
- Spend 10 minutes in prayer this week thanking God specifically for His unearned grace in your life.
