

# Sunday Supplement: Resurrect My Love (John 21)

## Summary Points

- Jesus meets us after failure—not after we fix ourselves.
- Love for Jesus is restored through honest humility: “Lord, you know.”
- Love is not just a feeling—it is expressed through action: “Feed my sheep.”
- God often rekindles our love for Him by giving us people to love.
- Restored love becomes sacrificial, taking the shape of daily obedience.

## Reflection Questions

- Where might Jesus be meeting you in a place of failure or drift?
- Have you been comparing your faith to others instead of being honest with God?
- Who are the “lambs” or “sheep” God has placed in your life right now?
- What would it look like to express your love for Jesus through action this week?

## Suggested Next Steps

- Practice one intentional act of care each day this week for someone specific.
- Ask daily: “Who needs encouragement, care, or protection today?”
- Pray honestly: “Lord, you know my heart—restore my love.”
- Choose one costly act of obedience this week (forgiveness, generosity, service).
