

Sunday Supplement: Resurrect My Finances From Ownership to Stewardship to Generosity

Summary Points

- God is the source of everything—you don't earn anything apart from Him.
- You are not an owner, but a steward—everything belongs to God.
- True blessing is not found in accumulation, but in generosity.
- God measures faithfulness, not financial success.
- When God resurrects your finances, fear turns into trust, ownership into stewardship, and accumulation into generosity.

Bottom Line: God doesn't bless what you keep—He blesses what you release.

2. Do you tend to think like an owner or a steward when it comes to your finances?
3. What would change if you truly believed everything you have belongs to God?
4. How has generosity (or lack of it) shaped your heart?
